Who is the Health Care-Supply Chain Management certificate designed for?

The Health Care – Supply Chain Management certificate is designed for those who wish to pursue a certificate while developing/enhancing their knowledge in health care in the Supply Chain Management field.

When do classes start?

Classes will begin in August 2008 and they are scheduled online, traditional day format and some evenings. You need to register at least two weeks in advance for the online classes and you must complete an Online Orientation on the LTC website prior to the start of the class in order to get a user name and password to access the course. Please complete an LTC application form and pay \$10 for the certificate program.

How much does each class cost?

The first three classes are 3 credits and each class costs approximately \$100 or more per credit plus the cost of the book (s). Most classes are 3 credits.
